- 1. The applicant makes application for:
 - (a) Pursuant to the Rules and Procedures for the conduct of the Leadership Election Process of the Progressive Conservative Party of Manitoba, an Order that the election result on October 30, 2021 declaring Heather Stefanson ("Stefanson") to be the premier-designate of Manitoba is invalid and that the office is vacant;
 - (b) In the alternative, an Order that the Applicant is duly elected to be the premier-designate of Manitoba;
 - (c) Costs of this Application; and

- 2. The grounds for the application are:

 - (b) On September 16, 2021, the Applicant and Stefanson were named as the two official candidates in the Election, which was scheduled to be held on October 30, 2021;
 - (c) On October 30, 2021, it was announced that Stefanson had won the Election by a margin of 363 votes, with 8,405 votes for Stefanson, and 8,042 votes for the Applicant;
 - (d) There were substantial irregularities in the Election, calculated to affect the result;
 - (e) Rules and Procedures for the conduct of the Leadership Election Process of the Progressive Conservative Party of Manitoba;
 - (f) Court of Queen's Bench Rule 14.05(2)(c)(iv); and
 - (g) Such further and other grounds as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may deem just.
